The *Revista Catarinense da Ciência Contábil* (RCCC) of the Regional Accounting Council of Santa Catarina reaches its twentieth volume and celebrates its 20th anniversary since its launch. This is an important milestone for its trajectory. During these two decades, the Journal obtained important victories and became a reference in accounting. With the mission of supporting scientific production, RCCC publishes materials produced by professors, researchers, students, and professionals from Brazil and abroad, selected based on quality and contribution to the development and dissemination of knowledge in this field.
